

RULES

1) The G.S. Ragusa Local Police announces and organizes the 16th "BAROQUE CITY CUP" and the 22nd edition of the "International Football Tournament of European Migration and Asylum", which will take place in Ragusa from 16 to 19 May 2024.

2) The teams must be made up of 5 players (4 + 1 goalkeeper).

Mixed teams must have at least 3 girls on the field. The goalkeeper can be man or woman; if it is a man he cannot go beyond the midfield.

In general, the rules of football apply to the goalkeeper (the ball can only be caught with the hands in the case of a back pass with the head or chest).

The throw-in must be done with the hands.

The corner kick with your feet.

3) The matches will last 18 minutes in a single half in the 1st phase (groups) and in the 2nd phase (round of 16, quarterfinals), in the event of a tie they will go directly to penalties (3 penalties). In the semi-finals and finals the matches will last 20 minutes (2 halves of 10 minutes), in case of a tie there will be 1 extra time of 5 minutes, in case of a tie there will be n. 5 penalties. The aforementioned matches cannot for any reason be brought forward, postponed or moved to a time/date other than those specified in the draw. If the entire team does not show up within the waiting time (5 minutes), the team that did not show up will lose the match with a score of 0-3.

4) The exchange of players between teams is prohibited. The team that does not respect this rule will lose the match with a score of 0 – 3.

5) In the final, 3rd/4th place, the matches will last 10 minutes for two halves and in the event of a tie, there will be a direct penalty shootout with 3 on each side. In the event of a further draw, a penalty will be taken on each side until one team makes a mistake.

6) During the race, changes are free. In the group stages, winning the match will award 3 points and a draw 1 point. The relative ranking will be drawn up according to the following criteria: 1) best score; 2) (in case of a tie) direct clash; 3) (in the event of a further draw) best overall goal difference; 4) better creation of made networks; 5) Draw.

- 7) As regards the men's tournament, the 1st and 2nd classified in each group will go to play the "Champions Tournament", while the 3rd and 4th classified will play the "Europa League Tournament".
- 8) Unless otherwise regulated by this regulation, the International Football Laws apply.
- 9) The teams must have 2 sets of shirts with the numbers applied on the back. Players must always wear shirts with the same number.
- 10) All matches will be managed by referees and assistants belonging to the G.A.C.I.-C.S.I. delegated by the C.O. For other decisions, the F.I.F.A. regulations apply.
